"For God is working in you, giving you the desire and the power to do what pleases Him." Philippians 2:13. The final numbers are in. Our children contributed \$2,721.32 which equals 22, 678 meals. This will feed the children of Uganda for 23 days which is 3 weeks & 2 days. The congregation contributed \$30,795.00 which equals to 256,208 meals. This will feed children for 258 days which is 36 weeks and 6 days or 8.5 months. The grand total contributed to Amazima is \$33,516.32 which totals 278,886 meals for 281 days (40 weeks). Meadowbrook will be able to feed the children of Uganda for just a little over 9 months. Meadowbrook has answered the call to feed the hungry, knowing that we are in fact acting as though we are feeding Christ Himself.
