**Blood Drive Scheduled:** Mississippi Blood Services (MBS) will be on Meadowbrook's campus Sunday, Oct. 9, 9am-1pm, for our semiyearly blood drive....and they need our help to cover blood needs throughout the state of Mississippi.

The MBS Donor Coach will be set up in the parking lot to receive donors—three, every 15 minutes....and, yes, you do have permission to go during class and during service! Sign-up sheets are available this morning through Friday, Oct. 7. Donors must be at least 16 years old and weigh 110 lbs. or more. They should eat and drink plenty of fluids before donating and be sure to **bring their I.D.**

All donors receive a T-shirt, and they and their immediate family will be covered under a \$10,000 secondary blood transfusion insurance policy for an entire year. If 25% of Meadowbrook members donate, all members plus their immediate family will receive the same coverage even if the member is unable to donate. The policy is renewed yearly provided the yearly goal is met. Our goal for the October blood drive is **25**.
