Want to Help Save a Life? How about three lives?!!! Mississippi Blood Services (MBS) will be on Meadowbrook's campus Sunday, Oct. 9, 9am-1pm, for our semi-yearly blood drive....and they need our help to cover blood needs throughout the state of Mississippi. **YOUR SINGLE DONATION CAN SAVE UP TO THREE LIVES!**

The MBS Donor Coach will be set up in the parking lot to receive donors—three, every 15 minutes. A sign-up sheet is available in the auditorium foyer and on Meadowbrook Connect under Needs. Contact Belinda Melson in the church office, 601.362.5374, with any questions concerning the blood drive.

Donors must be at least 16 years old and weigh 110 lbs. or more. They should eat and drink plenty of fluids before donating and be sure to **bring their I.D.** *Recent federal mandates require that all 16- and 17-year-olds must have written parental consent to donate. Consent forms are beside the donor sign-up sheet.

All donors receive a t-shirt, and they and their immediate family will be covered under a \$10,000 secondary blood transfusion insurance policy for an entire year. If 25% of Meadowbrook members donate, all members plus their immediate family will receive the same coverage even if the member is unable to donate. The policy is renewed yearly provided the yearly goal is met. Our goal for the October blood drive is **25**.
