Hurricane Relief Update The Meadowbrook hurricane relief team - Beau Cox, Stephen Henderson, and Judy Seabrook - is coordinating with the Churches of Christ Disaster Relief Team (DRT) to provide aid for people affected by Hurricanes Harvey and Irma. The first relief team, led by Blaine Totty, Jr. (the elder) will head to Beaumont, TX, Thursday, Sept. 28, 8am, and arrive around 2pm. They will return on Sunday, Oct. 1, late afternoon. There is still time to sign up for the Beaumont trip. All volunteers need to complete two forms: 1) the "Hurricane Relief Trips form," found on Meadowbrook Connect; 2) the "DRT Volunteer Registration form," found on their website, www.churchesofchristdrt.org/volunteersignup. Because the DRT does not have a tool trailer on site in Beaumont, volunteers are asked to bring their own tools. A suggested list of tools to bring will be provided soon. Volunteers will stay at Westgate Church of Christ, DRT's sponsor in Beaumont, and are asked to be prepared to bring an air mattress or pad and a sleeping bag or other sleeping gear.
