**Stewpot Ministries:** From July 5-8, Tuesday-Friday, it will again be Meadowbrook's turn to help with serving meals in the Community Kitchen at Stewpot. We have committed to do this for six weeks each year. It takes about two hours each day from 11:00-12:45 or 1:00—or any portion of that time frame—but it is time well spent.

The community Kitchen is just one of thirteen Stewpot ministries in downtown Jackson. Because of their limited staff, Stewpot relies on volunteer assistance. It takes a minimum of 8-10 volunteers to prepare the boxes for "Meals on Wheels" for approximately 80 people, to set up the food trays for approximately 120 people, and to serve the food and drinks in this period of time. *(continued on next page)*
