Water Distribution—Meadowbrook has been blessed to receive calls from churches in neighboring states offering to help by bringing bottled water to us. So far 93 cases of water were brought from the Church of Cornersville, TN. As of Wednesday evening, 45 cases had already been distributed to Jackson Meadowbrook members, preschool teachers, and preschool parents. Other shipments are expected Sunday and Monday from churches in Houston, TX, Little Rock, AR, and Huntsville, AL. We have asked for gallon jugs as well to assist with filling tanks during low water pressure. Distribution of this water will be from 12-1pm and 5-6pm Monday through Friday and will continue for as long as we have water to give out. An email will be forthcoming to ask for your help in unloading as well as in the distribution effort.

Stewpot—From September 12-16, Monday—Friday, it will again be Meadowbrook's turn to help with serving meals in the Community Kitchen at Stewpot. It takes about two hours each day from 11:00-12:45 or 1:00 or any portion of that time frame, but it is time well spent.
