Kemmel and Lisa Dunham work with Health Talents International in Guatemala Central American, in a ministry centered in Medical Evangelism. This approach involves meeting the immediate medical, social, and emotional requirements of patients while initiating relationships that allow them to get to know the spiritual needs of patients and have opportunities to share the gospel message. They have been in Guatemala since 2005 ministering to the Kiche' speaking churches, hosting mobile medical clinics, and training local church members to serve as health promoters or lay medical and dental assistants. Meadowbrook has been assisting with their support and has a number of members who are health care professionals that travel to Guatemala annually to assist in providing medical care at the Ezell Clinic, in Chichi, or in other areas of the country. We are thrilled that Kemmel and Lisa are going to be here on October19 to share their ministry experiences with all of us at both our Bible class and worship times.
